## 1.1 – SCOPE OF WORK

Designing Digitally Inc. has purchased a dedicated server and is currently running 0.5.9 OpenSim via standalone. Currently the system is able to handle what DDINC is currently doing; however there are additional requirements for this private grid OpenSim that DDINC would like to see implemented. These items are needed to improve the current system in hope to provide a professional private meeting space for DDINC.

The contractor will log into the Windows dedicated server using Windows Remote Desktop. The contractor will install and setup the newest stable version of OpenSim 0.6.3+ as a grid system that can be easily scaled up.

The contractor will compile the new version of OpenSim with the VOIP Integration [FreeSwitch].

The contractor will setup the Web Statistics Module which will allow DDINC to view those stats on the HTML/PHP web server on the Windows Dedicated Server.

The contractor will setup a database (databases provided by DDINC) for each of the following services: User, Grid, Asset, Inventory, and Messaging or UGAIM .

The contractor will setup the HTML/PHP page for DDINC to be able to register (register page) users to their grid.

The contractor will setup the HTML/PHP page for users to preview (login page) when attempting to log into DDINC grid.

The contractor will setup the HTML/PHP page for users to obtain their lost password.

The contractor will test the OpenSim to ensure the scripting, physics, groups, registration, VIOP, Web Stats are up and running correctly without any disruptions.

## 1.2 SPECIFICATIONS

The Contractor will provide a per project price for the entire scope of work provided above.

The Contractor will provide a timeline for this development

The Contractor will provide examples of previous work regarding setup of the OpenSim.

## **2.1 – AGREEMENT - Payment**

Owner will pay contractor a lump sum for the project for services rendered under this contract. The contractors will bill Designing Digitally Inc. in **two** installments. Installment one is billed when the development is setup and ready for Designing Digitally, Inc.'s review. Installment two is paid in full when Designing Digitally, Inc. has signed off on the project.

## **2.2 – AGREEMENT – Relationship of Parties**

The parties intend that an independent contractor-employer relationship will be created by this contract. Owner is interested only in the results to be achieved and the conduct and control of the work will lie solely with contractor. Contractor is not to be considered an agent or employee of owner for any purpose, and the employees of contractor are not entitled to any of the benefits that owner provides for owner's employees. It is understood that owner does not agree to use contractor exclusively. It is further understood that contractor is free to contract for similar services to be performed for other owners while under contract with owner.

## **2.2 – AGREEMENT – Liability**

The work to be performed under this contract will be performed entirely at contractor's risk, and contractor assumes all responsibility for the condition of tools and equipment used in the performance of this contract. Contractor agrees to indemnify owner for any and all liability or loss arising in any way out of the performance of this contract. Designing Digitally Inc. is not liable for any and all bodily injury and/or chronic illnesses that may arise during the period of this contract.

## **2.2 – AGREEMENT – Duration**

The contract shall remain in force until the scope of work stated above in this document is completed and the client has signed off on all projects.
